Mode of Instruction

- In Person Faculty and students are scheduled in a particular classroom or laboratory during a set day/time.
- Online Online courses let students and faculty interact with each other as class members entirely over the Internet. Instructional courseware utilizes web pages, discussion groups and UWGB e-mail. Online courses do not meet at a particular time or place, but they are structured within the academic semester timeframe and require class participation several times each week.
- Blended A blended course is a course where the content is taught using face-to-face and online or "time-out-of-class" learning modes. Blended courses are approximately 40-60% online with the remainder conducted face-to-face.
- Virtual Classroom Faculty and students interact with each other as class members entirely over the Internet. Faculty and students converse and interact with each other's coursework while viewing each other in a real-time classroom setting.
- In Person w/online capability Faculty and students are scheduled in a particular classroom or laboratory during a set day/time. Lectures and class sessions are recorded and accessed via the Internet.
