

Organizational Leadership - Bachelor of Arts

The Bachelor of Arts Degree with a major in Organizational Leadership is primarily an online bachelor's degree program designed to promote an interdisciplinary education providing a strong foundation of leadership skills with a focus on communication, critical thinking, and problem-solving.
